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From Classroom To Career: Students from Kulachi Hansraj and Vandana International School Explored FDDI's Campus And Industry Opportunities





A group of students from Kulachi Hansraj Model School visited the campus on May 1st, 2025, followed by the students of Vandana international school, Dwarka on 16th May 2025. During the visit, the students explored all four Schools and gained valuable insights into these sectors. The visit provided a unique opportunity for the students to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application with a special focus on the dynamic world of visual merchandising. During their time in campus, the students had the opportunity to tour the state-of-the-art retail studio, a dedicated space designed to simulate real-world retail environments. This immersive experience allowed them to witness various first-hand facets of visual merchandising, from window display designs to in-store product presentation. Experts provided detailed explanations of the principles and techniques involved in creating compelling visual displays that attract customers and drive sales. They also had the opportunity to explore the world-class infrastructure at all the other three schools.

The students also received comprehensive information about footwear, leather, retail and fashion design sectors including career opportunities and the evolving trends shaping the industry. This exposure provided a holistic understanding to the students and exposed them to potential career paths in these dynamic fields.

Ethiopian Delegation Visit



On 10th May 2025, FDDI, Noida Campus had the privilege of hosting an eight-member delegation from United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) and its partner institutions. The delegation included Shri Bogale Feleke Temesgen, Shri Wondu Legesse Gizaw, and Shri Seble Daniel Solomon from UNIDO; Shri Zulfikar Abajihad Ababushen and Shri Dagnew Negasa Urgesa from Leather and Leather Products Industry Research & Development Centre (LLPIRDC); Ms. Sintayehu Befekadu Gossa from Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA); Shri Neway Alemu Bekele from Modjo City Administration; and Shri Dagnachew Abebe Amea from Ethiopian Leather Industries Association (ELIA). The delegation explored new avenues for collaboration in the development of non-leather products and laboratory testing capabilities. While Ethiopia boasts a robust leather raw material base, the delegation expressed keen interest in diversifying into the non-Leather segment, which now represents nearly 70% of global footwear consumption.

In this regard, UNIDO delegation met Shri Vivek Sharma, MD, FDDI, to strengthen business ties and to forge linkages further. The meeting also included the presence of key FDDI officials - Col. Pankaj Kumar Sinha, Secretary, FDDI, Ms. Manju Maan, ED, FDDI Noida, Shri Sharad Srivastava, Chief Faculty and Shri Deepak Choudhary, HOD (SFDP) along with Shri S.K. Verma, ED, IFCOMA. During the discussions, Shri Vivek Sharma emphasized the importance of a cluster based approach to foster inclusive and sustainable sectoral growth. The ongoing Twinning Project, a long-standing collaborative initiative between India and Ethiopia since 2010, was also reviewed with both parties recognizing its significant contributions in benchmarking and enhancing Ethiopia's leather and footwear industry performance.

As part of the campus tour, the delegation visited FDDI's International Testing Center, a state of the art facility equipped with comprehensive chemical and physical laboratories. These labs specialize in testing leather, footwear components, textiles, plastics, and allied materials. The technical team at the Testing Center provided detailed insights into the testing procedures being followed. The delegation also explored FDDI's Product Development Center, where they received demonstrations on CAD/CAM technology, and toured the non-Leather Center, which showcases capabilities in virtual modeling, knitting, UV applications, and pilot plant operations. Advanced systems including 3D printing, UV and laser technologies, and CAD/CAM based design tools were highlighted as an integral part to a modern and sustainable footwear manufacturing.

The session focused on the critical role of threads and yarns in garment finishing, emphasizing their impact on product quality and durability. Drawing from his extensive industry experience, Shri Minhas shared in depth knowledge about wide variety of threads used in garment construction and finishing. The interactive lecture highlighted the practical applications of different thread compositions and how they contribute to the overall quality and aesthetic of finished garments.
