JCOS VISITED WAREHOUSE EXPO 2025 FOR PRACTICAL INDUSTRY EXPOSURE







On 27th June 2025, the Junior Commissioned Officers' enrolled in Retail Management Certification program, they visited "Warehouse Expo 2025" at Yashobhoomi, Dwarka. The visit offered practical exposure to the evolving landscape of warehouse management, logistics and supply chain operations. The JCOs explored a wide range of advanced tools, machinery and software solutions focused on efficient inventory management. They observed live demonstrations of robotics, automation and virtual reality applications in warehousing and supply chain functions. Through these experiences, they gained insights into how emerging technologies enhance speed, accuracy and operational efficiency. The visit helped JCOs link classroom learning with real-world practices and understand the need for innovation in today's supply chains.

DEFENCE OFFICERS VISITED BHUTANI CITY CENTRE FOR EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING ON MALL OPERATIONS







A delegation of Junior Commissioned Officers (JCOs) from the Indian Army, Navy and Air Force visited Bhutani City Centre, Noida, on 30th June 2025 as a part of a structured educational program aimed at providing real-world exposure to modern retail operations and infrastructure management. The visit was coordinated in collaboration with faculty members, Dr. Renu Sharma and Dr. Aastha Garg, who accompanied the officers during the guided tour. The session focused on giving participants a comprehensive understanding of how large commercial facilities are managed and secured in real time. The officers were briefed by the mall management team on several key areas, including security protocols, firefighting systems, routine maintenance practices and standard operating procedures (SOPs). The management's hands-on demonstration and detailed walkthrough allowed the visiting officers to engage with the operational backend of the retail environment — an experience rarely accessible to those outside the commercial sector.

JCOS VISIT ALPINE INDUSTRIES FOR FOOTWEAR MANUFACTURING EXPOSURE







On 27th June 2025, a group of Junior Commissioned Officers enrolled in Certificate course in Footwear Manufacturing and Retailing at FDDI, Noida, visited Alpine Industries as part of their industry exposure program. The objective was to introduce them to organized footwear manufacturing processes and operations.

The visit commenced with a tour of the sole manufacturing unit, where the participants observed two major production techniques: EVA injection molding used for Reebok soles and rubber vulcanization for Adidas soles. They gained insights into the machinery, raw materials and procedures involved in creating various types of soles. The group then proceeded to the full shoe assembly unit producing Adidas footwear. With a daily output of 8,000 to 10,000 pairs, the facility showcased the scale and diversity of production across different shoe models and designs. The experience offered JCOs a deeper understanding of the structured processes within the footwear industry and encouraged several of them to explore possibilities of setting up their own manufacturing units in the future.
