Dr. Pal is a recipient of Technology Group Award, Scientist of the Year Award from DRDO for his research contributions. Dr. Pal is also recipient of Prof. Chitaleakha Mukherjee and Prof B B Sarkar Memorial Oration awards from The Physiological Society of India.
